## **Replacement Sink and covers**

The original sink in the rig was ok, but that's about it... the longer trips we took and the more time we spent on the road convinced us that a double sink would be nice... unfortunately, there were none that fit in the room available to us... so, we found <u>Southwest Custom Stainless</u> and got a quote for a custom one... using a cardboard template, they welded up exactly what we needed, and I proceeded to install it.... That was not as hard as it sounds, the cutting of the opening being the most time consuming... the plumbing, actually lined up with minimal modifications, and off-the-shelf hoses completed the task....

## **Splash Shield**

Since we converted the dinette to a permanent bed, there was the concern of thing falling or spilling on the pillows and mattress. With the new sink we addressed this issue by putting a custom Lexan splash shield on the end of the counter. This was one of those items that you looked around the garage and low and behold, there it was a scrap you could never quite bring yourself to tossing out.

And so, a bit of cutting, sanding, and staining, along with the odd piece of Velcro and this project was done.
